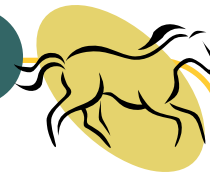

Schedule & Rules



Morning Showjumping—commencing at 09:30

- **Beginners Class**—Entries close at 09:15, class starts at 09:30 £9
- Class height will not exceed 60cm
- Not eligible to Open Entries
- **Novice Class**—Entries close at 10:15, Class starts at 10:30 £9
- Class Height will not exceed 70cm
- Not Eligible to Open Entries

Afternoon Show Jumping—commencing at 13:00

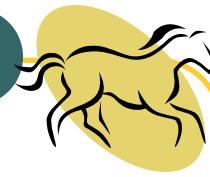
- **Intermediate Class**—Entries close at 12:45, class starts at 13:00 £9
- Class height will not exceed 80cm
- **Open Class**—Entries close at 14:45, Class starts at 15:00 £9
- Class Height will not exceed 90cm
- **Accumulator Class (if time permits)**—Entries close at 16:00, Class starts at 16:30 £9
- Class Height will not exceed 1m

Clear Round Ring—running all day £5

- Clear Round Class runs in the arena adjacent to the indoor school (access is from parking field), last entry for clear round taken at 16:45
- Entry ticket will be given when you pay for the class, please hand this into the steward on the gate when entering the main arena. Competitors will be allowed no more than 2 minutes in the ring.
- Warm up is in the small arena at top of indoor school. Due to the size of the warm up arena, a maximum of 10 horses at any time will be allowed in. Only when you are ready to go into the warm arena will you be able to declare, and then you will be called when it is your turn to jump.
- When you enter the main arena, please make sure you pass the judges box, at the side of the arena, so that they can get your number. The bell will sound when you can start.
- **2 phase rounds**—If you complete a clear round, you will then immediately jump your speed round. A whistle will sound when you can start. It is up to competitors to ensure they know the speed course. Each fence down will mean 4 seconds added to your overall time. The speed round is listed at the secretary's desk and on the declaration board.
- The time starts when the horse lifts over the first fence and stops when the horse lands over the last fence
- Accumulator class—will be run if time permits and we have over 10 entrants. Fences may be jumped in any order, in the time limit of 45 seconds. If a pole is knocked down, the fence cannot be jumped again—the rider with the most points wins!
- There will be rosettes from first to sixth places, with trophies for first place.
- The classes are held in the main indoor arena—for health and safety reasons only the competitors and event staff will be allowed entry to the arena from the warm up arena. Please view from the designated viewing galleries.
- The faults are as follows:

Each Knock Down - 4 faults
First Disobedience - 4 faults
Second Disobedience - 4 faults
Third Disobedience - Elimination
Fall of rider and/or horse - Elimination
Wrong Course - Elimination
- All judges decisions are final.

Conditions Applying to all Shows

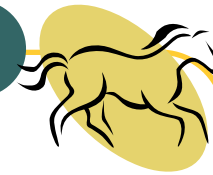


1. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for anything that may happen to competitors, their horses, property or helpers in connection with or arising from this show. It will be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agree to indemnify the Mill Lane Equestrian Centre & the Organisers against any legal action arising therefrom. Entries are made entirely at the competitors own risk.
2. The decision of the judges is final. Any objection should be made to the organisers, within 15 minutes of the class ending.
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or amend the schedule at any time.
4. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted. We strongly recommend the wearing of a protective helmet manufactured to the latest British Standard or such other suitable headgear as offers a similar or higher level of protection and is at least that of British Standard EN1384. No competitor will be allowed to compete without suitable headgear. Body protectors are strongly recommended.
5. No abuse of the horse will be tolerated, competitors who are considered to be committing this will be asked to leave.
6. Lunging is not permitted anywhere on the premises of Mill Lane Equestrian Centre.
7. All children must be accompanied by an adult—especially when mounted.
8. No entry will be accepted without the correct entry fee.
9. Entries will be taken on a first come, first served basis. Entry fees for withdrawals will not be refunded unless the resulting space can be filled.
10. Prize money and rosettes are as stated in the schedule

Health & Safety

The organisers of this show have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For those measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards. No dogs or smoking are allowed anywhere on the Mill Lane Equestrian Centre premises.
